

Open Call for Magapor's Technical Congress Poster Conquest

AIM

The purpose of this call is to encourage the production of high-quality scientific research and showcase the research activities carried out at universities and companies. The best scientific poster related to the pig sector, specifically in the phase of female and boar reproduction, will be awarded.

AMOUNT

The 10 highest-rated posters will be displayed at the Magapor Technical Congress (ITM 2025) by their authors. Candidates who submit the 10 highest-rated posters will be able to attend the congress lectures free of charge, as well as the corresponding meals. For candidates presenting the 3 best posters, the following monetary awards will be granted: €1000 for the first place, €750 for the second, and €500 for the third. This prize will be subject to the deductions and taxes established by current legislation, which will be subtracted from the corresponding monetary award.

POSTER TOPICS (ONLY PORCINE, SWINES AND BOARS)

- Reproduction management and good practices
- Viral infections
- Bacterial infections
- Biosecurity and epidemiology
- Nutrition and welfare
- Genetic improvement
- Facilities
- New reproductive technologies

POSTER STRUCTURE AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Prior to the presentation at the congress, the poster should have the following characteristics:

- -I must not exceed 1000 words, including title and references.
- -The content should be structured in the following sections: Title, Introduction, Material and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion and References.
- -Language must be english.



Moreover, the abstract of the poster should be attached with the poster with 1000 words maximum.

Characteristics and poster form:

- -It should be 70 cm long by 50 cm width and it will include the congress logo (17ITM). In case of adding images or other graphic elements hey should be in proper resolutions for the impression in the right form.
- -The title must be in the upper part, followed by the names and author references and finally the development of the information related to the study to be presented.
- -Font will be by choice of the author, taking into account that it should be readable. Title size should be at least 60 pt and text size 25 pt minimum. Tables, graphs or lists should synthesize and present the information in the most visual way.

A maximum of two references are allowed (first author, year, journal, volume, pages) of full published papers.

POSTER SENDING

The poster for the communication must be submitted as an attached .PDF or .PPT file to the following contact email: **vetelab@magapor.com** for evaluation, along with the contact details of one of the authors, who will be the contact person (email address).

By submitting the poster, the author acknowledges that the work has not been previously published and belongs to the named authors, who agree to be listed as co-authors and that the experiments have been conducted under the appropriate legal authority.

POSTER ACCEPTATION

The authors will be informed of the arrival of the poster and abstract through the contact author. Please refrain from making inquiries about the status of the abstract after submission. The authors will be notified by email as soon as the results are published.

POSTER ASSESSMENT

Catedra's Mixed Commission formed by a group of professors and researchers of University of Zaragoza will evaluate and rate the poster.

The results of the conquest will be published April 30th. The winning authors should print and bring the poster to the Congress so it can be exposed at the conference.

POSTER PRESENTATION

Posters will be displayed in a high-visibility area on the first day of the conference. During the breaks between presentations, the authors of the posters will be able to answer questions from the attendees about their posters. The awards to the winners will be given before the conference's break.
